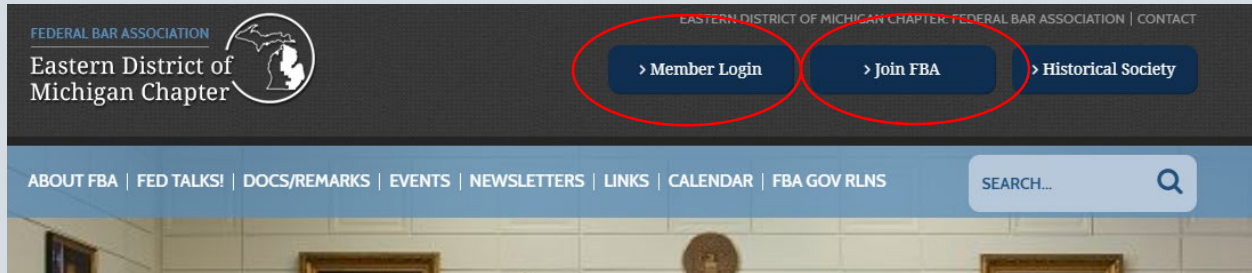


ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORMER AND CURRENT FEDERAL LAW CLERKS OF THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF MICHIGAN AND SIXTH CIRCUIT

The Law Clerk Committee of the Federal Bar Association of the Eastern District of Michigan is pleased to announce a new and improved database cataloging over 850 current and former law clerks hailing from the EDMI and Sixth Circuit.

To access the database, simply follow the instructions below: (please note that non-Chapter members residing in Michigan are limited to a 60-day free access period ending October 31, 2019.)

1. First, start by going to the FBA, Eastern District of Michigan website – located at www.fbamich.org
2. Existing FBA members can simply log-in by selecting the ‘Member Login’ button at the top of the screen. Non-members should select the ‘Join FBA’ button



The ‘Member Login’ button will take you to the login page shown. If you do not recall your password, click the ‘Need help logging in?’ link for further direction:



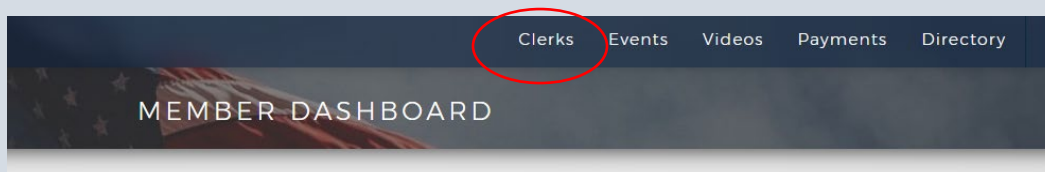


