# CHIEF JUDGE JAMES P. CHURCHILL TO SPEAK TO CHAPTER

On Wednesday, October 25, 1989, the Honorable James P. Churchill, Chief Judge United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan will speak to the Chapter and deliver an address on the State of the Court. The luncheon will be held in the Riverfront Ballroom of Detroit Westin Hotel. Chief Judge Churchill graduated from the University of Michigan School of Business Administration in 1947, and received his J.D. from the University of Michigan Law School in 1950. From 1950 to 1965 he practiced law in the City of Vassar. He then served as Circuit Judge in the 40th Judicial Circuit for Lapeer and Tuscola Counties from 1965 through 1974. He began serving as a U. S. District Judge in the Eastern District of Michigan on December 30, 1974.
