The Honorable Julian Abele Cook, Chief Judge, United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan will be the featured speaker at the first membership luncheon of the 1993-1994 year on September 28, 1993. Chief Judge Cook received his law degree from Georgetown University. He was appointed to the Court by President Jimmy Carter in 1978 after engaging in private practice from 1968 to 1978 in Pontiac, Michigan. He served as the Chair of the State Civil Rights Commission from 1969 to 1971.

GENEVA HALLIDAY IS ELECTED SIXTH CIRCUIT OFFICER

Geneva Halliday, immediate past president of the Detroit Chapter, has been elected Circuit Officer for the Sixth Circuit in a contested election. Geneva will take the oath of office at the Federal Bar Association's annual meeting and convention in New Orleans on Saturday, October 23, 1993.

The Circuit Officers are members of the Federal Bar Association's National Council. In addition to being members of the Association's governing body, Circuit Officers serve as a liaison with all Chapters within that officer's circuit. The Circuit Officers are responsible for organizing, coordinating and promoting membership growth and renewal in the individual chapters as well as helping the chapters sponsor continuing legal education programs. The Circuit Officers also work to supply the chapters with information on National's activities. The Circuit Officers may also undertake and supervise the creation of new chapters or reactivation of inactive chapters.

The Sixth Circuit has ten chapters. Geneva has indicated that she will use the Detroit Chapter's many activities as models in assisting

the other chapters with their programs. Although she has not yet been sworn-in, Geneva is in the process of contacting the president of each chapter.
